A. TUITION

K4 through 3rd grade:	\$7,300.00

4th through 12th grade:	\$6,740.00

Annual Total	\$7,160.00
10 Installments:	\$ 716.00/month

We do not want price to stop any family from applying to our Christian school. There is no cost for national standardized achievement tests each year. The cost of this standardized testing is included in our tuition. If money is an issue, please call the school office.

Tuition payments are prorated over ten months, with the first payment due BEFORE the school year begins. For new students the first month's tuition is due upon acceptance as a student.

If a family has pre-paid tuition and/or a student must be taken out of school for the remainder of the year, tuition will be refunded for the remainder of the year based upon the number of days the student was enrolled.

B. FEES BILLED ON INVOICES

Registration: A flat-rate per family registration fee of \$50 will be charged to the family of students new to the school this year. This registration fee will not be charged to families of returning students, provided they re-enroll their child(ren) before the last day of school of the previous school year. If they do not turn in their re-enrollment forms, scholarship award letters and/or financial agreement forms, and health forms (see Section VII above) by the last day of school, they will be charged a \$50 registration fee to re-enroll on their August 1st invoice.

Musical Instrument Rental Fees: If a student uses a WCA-owned instrument to participate in our WCA band classes, a \$60 annual fee will be charged on the September invoice.

Special Workshop Fees: When WCA offers a special workshop as part of our regular school day schedule, the fees for this workshop will be billed on the next invoice.

Graduation Expense Fees: K5 and high school graduates can expect certain graduation expenses on one of their last invoices in May.

Returned Check Fees: Bank charges for returned checks will be charged back to the family by whom the check was written.

C. FEES NOT BILLED ON INVOICES

Sports Fees: Fees for participation in our sports program are as follows (per sport):

- \$45 for first child in a family
 - \$40 for second child in the same family
 - \$25 for third child in the same family
- (Not to exceed \$110 total per family)

All sports fees must be paid before a student is allowed to participate in sports, be issued a uniform, or be placed on the roster.

Late Pick-Up Fees: There will be a stiff "late fee" for any student who has not been picked up (or left campus) within 10 minutes of the time that the child should be picked up (or gone), UNLESS that student is still on campus under special approval. ("Special Approval" is that the parent or guardian is on campus, or the student is working for the school or attending approved sports or music practices). Please do not put the administration in the embarrassing position of asking for exceptions to this. If you are not able to pick up your child, please make arrangements for someone else to pick them up. The rates for the late fees are for every 10 minutes late a child stays at school \$5 will be charged, with a maximum charge of \$30 per day.

ALL LATE PICKUP FEES MUST BE PAID TO THE TEACHER WHO STAYED LATE WITH YOUR CHILD BEFORE THE STUDENT RETURNS TO SCHOOL THE NEXT DAY.

Fees for Lost or Damaged Items: A \$5.00 charge will be written on the child's goal book and payment will be expected in cash by the next day for lost or defaced items such as goal books, student envelopes, star charts, PACES. A charge to cover replacement of books not returned by the last day of class, or school property that is lost, damaged, or destroyed by a student will be written on the child's goal book and payment will be expected in cash by the next day.

Field Trip Fees: Parents will receive a letter inviting their child to participate in field trips periodically throughout the school year. These trips are not mandatory and parents will be asked to sign a permission slip. The fees for these field trips must be paid before the date of the field trip.

Student Convention Fees: Student Convention fees are treated in the same way as field trip fees. Parents will receive a letter inviting their child to participate, outlining the fees required, and a permission slip will be included. The fees for Student Convention must be paid before the deadline outlined in the permission letter.

Chapel Fines and School Supplies: Fines for not bringing needed items (Scripture sheet, Bible, etc.) to Chapel each day and for school supplies sold to a student (pencils, pens, erasers, paper, etc.) will be written on the child's goal book and payment will be expected in cash by the next day.

Report Cards may be held until all fees and tuition have been paid, unless other arrangements have been made.
